

Educational Scholarships 2012-13

In keeping with the vision of the college to enable students who are socially and economically disadvantaged and unable to pursue higher education, the college offers numerous scholarships and fee concessions. The below mentioned are the various kinds of scholarships made available by the college: the SC/ST Scholarship, the SC/ST Educational Loan Scholarship, Post-Matric Minority Scholarship, Mrs. Jojiammal Under-privileged Students Scholarship of Rev Fr N Arul Devadoss, Fr. Lawenceraj Silver Jubilee Sports Scholarship, German Private Scholarship, Rehoboth Scholarship, Rosario Scholarship and Fr. P.B. Martin SAM Scholarship.

- On 21st December 2012 during the Christmas Celebration Mrs. Jojiammal Under-privileged Students Scholarship amounting to Rs. 1,50,000 for 60 students, Rehoboth Scholarship amounting to Rs. 45,000 for 5 students and Rosario Scholarship amounting to Rs. 20,000 for 3 students & German Private Scholarship amounting to Rs. 90,000 for 30 students were awarded.
- On January 28th 2013, the SC/ST Scholarship for this year alone amounting to Rs. 10,41,290 for 299 students, SC/ST Educational Loan Scholarship amounting to Rs. 84,000 for 12 students were given.
- On 6th February 2013 Fr. Lawrence Raj Sports Scholarship amounting to Rs. 1,00,000 for 45 students were awarded. Here, I wish to place on record the fact that Rev. Fr. Lawrence Raj contributed Rs 20 lakhs to the college in 2008 and that was paid to the government as the mandatory Endowment Fund. This 20 lakhs was from donations received at his Priestly Silver Jubilee celebrations. Later Fr. Lawrence Raj also gave another 10 lakhs which is with us as a Fixed Deposit. The interest from these FDs is given each year to deserving students as Sports Scholarships. Thank you, Fr. Lawrence.
- Financial assistance by way of free education and concession by the college management is provided to the students which is amounting to more than Rs. 5,21,290.
- Fr. P.B. Martin, secretary of the college through his personal and his NGO funds helped eight students who belong to ST community by paying their entire College and Hostel fees amounting to Rs. 2,40,000.

- It is worth to report that we have applied the Reimbursement of fees to the SC/ST students which is amounting to Rs. 12,31,200 for 300 students. Christ benefitted students
- Hence by calculating all the amount together, the college gave away Rs. 35,22,780 as scholarship. College holds its head high with pride for this noble work and for standing tall in comparison to any other college in this vicinity. Here I must mention Mr. Soundar, the Physical Director and thank him on behalf of and the college for his strenuous work and great service.
